Departure and Arrival Information

Departure:

All Year 8 students attending camp are required to meet at the front of the Coolock Campus, near reception, at 7.30am on their designated day of departure. Buses will depart at 8.00am sharp.

Return:

Students will return to the Coolock Campus at approximately 5.30pm on the final day of their camp. Buses will drop students off at the front of the College.

Parent/Carer Instructions:

To ensure a smooth pick-up and drop-off process, parents and carers are asked to enter the College via Gates 3 and 4 and park in the Visitor or Staff Car Park. Please do not enter via Gate 1.

Transport

Students will be transported by bus to and from camp. A College vehicle will also be driven to the venue.

Departure Day Details

Students are required to bring a drink bottle, morning tea and lunch for the first day in a backpack/day pack. No food containing nuts or eggs is permitted. All other meals will be provided.

No On-Site Classes at Coolock Campus During Camp Week

Students attending camp:

The Coolock Campus will be closed for the week (Monday 17 March – Friday 21 March) while Year Level Camps are taking place.

As students are attending camp in two separate groups, they will have rest days at home when not on camp.

Please ensure you are aware of your child's allocated camp dates, which can be found on the PAM consent, and that appropriate arrangements are made for their rest days at home.

Students not attending camp:

There will be no alternative program offered at the College during this week, so students who are not attending camp are required to remain at home for the duration of the entire week.

Medical

If your child is required to take medication during the camp it is compulsory that a Medication Authority Form is completed and signed off by a doctor/parent/carers. Please see attached.

Please return the form and medication to the Coolock General Office by Friday 7 March at the latest.

A qualified medical professional will be onsite each day during activity hours and on call at all other times for the duration of the camp.
